

**Procedure B**: The second set of diagrams identifies four types of index fossils and shows two columns of fossil bearing rock strata.


- 1. Reconstruct the complete sequence of events and draw the layers (with the fossils if present) on the appropriate column on the next page.


Index of Different Geologic Periods:
